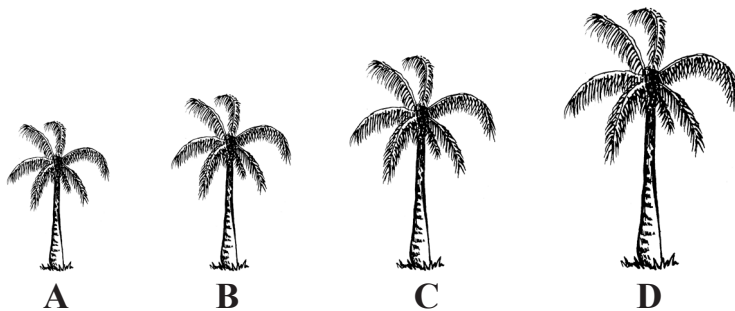

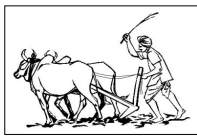

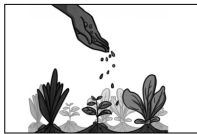

21. One day, a stranger came to Tenali Rama’s house. He met Tenali Rama and said, “I come from a far off village. I am very tired. Will

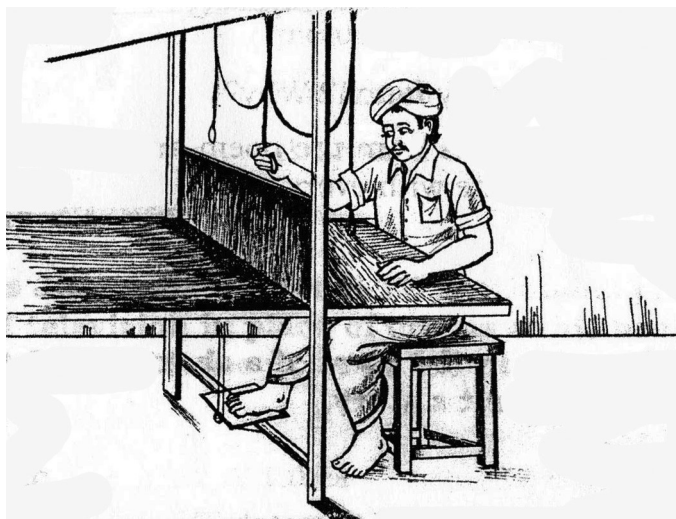
you give me shelter for two days? I will stay here for two days and then go away.” Tenali Rama readily agreed.

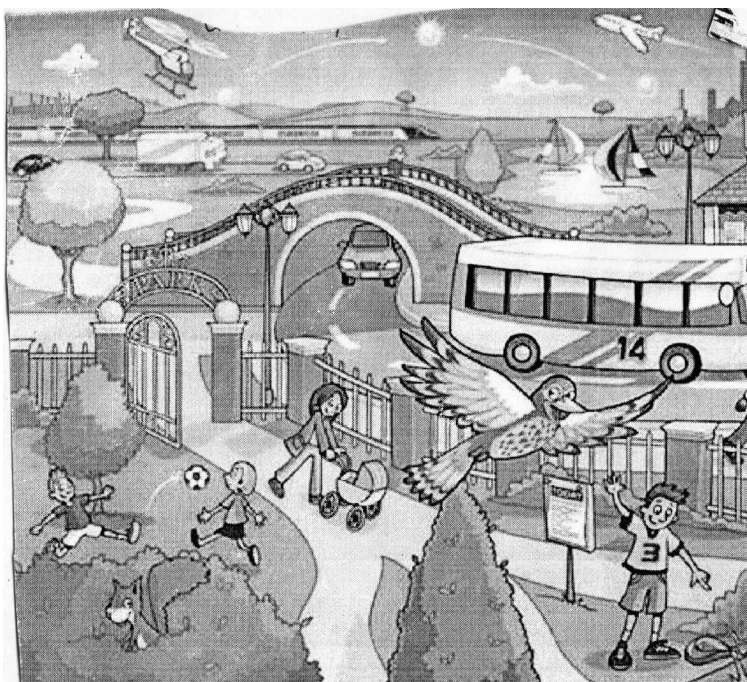
