3. 1st Language & Core Subjects : 10.30am to 1.45pm & 2nd Language & 3rd Language: 10.30am to 1.30pm
4. For JTS: Engineering Graphics(72) examination will be conducted from 2.30pm to 5.45 pm
5. For Karnataka Music/Hindustani Music examination will be conducted from 2 pm to 5.15pm
6. For NSQF subjects examination will be conducted from 10.30AM to 12.45PM
7. For NSQF students 2 hours for writing the exam and 15 minutes for reading the question paper.
