
1. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: -

The applicant

- shall be a proprietary / partnership firm / Pvt. Ltd. Company / Public Ltd. Company Or Re-pulping Industry.
- shall be an Income Tax Assessee during the last three financial years viz., 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23 i.e., Assessment years 2021-22, 2022-23 and 2023-24 respectively.
- should have an average turnover of at least Rs.50.00 lakhs in the past three financial years viz., 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23
- should possess GST NUMBER obtained from Department of Commercial Tax, Government of Karnataka.
- should have the experience of disposal of confidential paper in the last two years in preceeding three years.
- PAN cardcopy.

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3. e- AUCTION SALE TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- i) Printed Question Papers are packed in carton boxes and then polythene envelopes stored at DDPU offices across Karnataka
- ii) Material shall be weighed in two Different Licensed weigh bridges before loading (empty vehicle) and after loading in the presence of Committee Constituted by the respective DDPU. The Highest weight among the two weigh bridges shall be considered for calculation of weight.
- iii) Sale value shall be calculated based on the weight of the Material
- iv) Material will be permitted to be lifted against full Advance payment of sale value and all statutory taxes on "As is where is basis on weight Basis"
- v) Under any circumstances material shall not be lifted from the respective DDPU offices before the payment to the KSEAB.
- vi) **The materials are sold As is where is on weight Basis only. Therefore, the bidder is at liberty to inspect all the material stored in the Different districts of Karnataka or any one district. Objections in this regard shall not be acceptable by the Board after the Bidding in anyway.**
- vii) Sale will be made as per the sale terms and conditions of the tender document which are not negotiable.
- viii) The successful bidder should lift from respective DDPU the material within specified time from the date of issue of work orders by the KSEAB.
- ix) Lifting of material should start immediately as mentioned in work order a
- x) **The AIA reserves the right to issue the order to lifting the material to the successful bidder.**
- xi) **The Auctioned material being very confidential in nature, the successful bidder should dispose the material by re-pulping in bulk only without a single paper /portion in the box being made available in public under any circumstances.**
- xii) Agreement should be made by the successful bidder to dispose the purchased PU Old question papers which are in various districts of Karnataka(Annexure enclosed) on As is where it is basis on weight Basis pertaining to 2022-23 PU and Previous examinations on a stamp paper of value of Rs. 200/- .
- xiii) The successful bidder should transport the material intact at their own cost. If any discrepancy found in the process of transportation, legal action shall be initiated on the bidder. Undertaking in the format enclosed at Annexure –II shall have to be submitted in this regard.
- xiv) **Inspection of material:** Interested bidder may visit any one district with the prior permission from KSEAB to inspect the Papers within closing date and before time of the e-auction, only during working hours.
- xv) **Any corrigendum, addendum or clarification to the e-Auction document shall be published only in the e-procurement portal.**
- xvi) **Submission of queries after the pre-bid meeting is prohibited. All queries pertaining to the e-Auction document shall be submitted on day of pre-bid meeting only.**

4. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT [EMD]:-

- i) EMD needs to be paid by the bidder through e-Auction platform as mentioned in Para 2 above.
- ii) The refund of EMD for unsuccessful bidders will be made after entering into an agreement with the successful bidder.
- iii) The earnest money deposit may be forfeited If a Bidder:
 - a) Withdraws its Bid during the period of bid validity period or
 - b) In case of successful bidder fails to sign the Contract and furnish the performance security within due date.

5. SALE VALUE & PERFORMANCE SECURITY

- i) The EMD of the successful bidder shall be retained as performance security. The variable amount of 5% performance security of the material value, bid amount & Tax amount shall be payable by the successful bidder through Demand Draft from any Nationalized Bank only drawn in favour of "The Director Exams KSEAB Bangalore" within 7 days of the receipt of notification of award of contract from the KSEAB & 5% performance security shall be returned after the satisfactory completion of all the obligations under the e-auction.
- ii) The successful bidder shall deposit the sale value in advance , along with performance Security through Demand Draft from any Nationalized Bank only, drawn in favor of "The Director - Exams, KSEAB, Bengaluru or through RTGS to K.S.E.A Board Bank Account within 07(seven) days of the receipt of the "Notification of Award". If the bidder fails to deposit the Sale Value within stipulated time, K.S.E.A Board will forfeit the EMD/Performance Security along with Blacklisting the Bidder. In such events, K.S.E.A. Boards shall award the bid to the next highest evaluated Bidder and so on until the completion of "Notification of Award" process within the validity period of e-auction or invite a new auction. KSEAB reserves the right to either accept the bid Or reject without citing any reason, the decision of KSEAB is final in this regard.

6. UPLOADING OF BIDDER'S CREDENTIALS / ELIGIBILITY DOCUMENTS

- i) The bidder shall upload the following documents in Term e-Auction Platform for the purpose of Pre-Qualification to e-Auctions.
- ii) Certificate confirming proprietary firm (from Bank or Chartered Accountant) / partnership firm (Partnership Deed copy) / private limited company / public limited company (Memorandum & Articles of Association)
- iii) Income Tax Assessed for the last three financial year's viz., 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23 Copies of Assessment Order / copy of Returns filed. (In case the bidder is liable for a tax audit, can submit the last three financial years' returns filed, viz., 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23, but for the purpose of Annual Turnover can submit latest three financial year's viz., 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23).
- iv) Annual Turnover of at least **Rs.50.00** lakhs on an average in the past three year's viz. 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23. The financial Turn over documents shall be verified & attested by registered statutory Accountant/Auditor
- v) Copies of GST Registration Certificates.
- vi) PAN Card copy.
- vii) Should have the experience of disposal of confidential paper for last two years in the preceeding three years.
- viii) Bidder Details in Annexure-1 of this Document and other certificates as per annexure II, III, IV, V & VI.
- ix) **The bidder is eligible only if an UNDERTAKING AS PER ANNEXURE-II is uploaded certifying the maintaining confidentiality of the material and transportation of material to the mill for Re-pulping only.**

7. SUBMISSION OF ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS: -

- i) The bidder shall submit the originals of the uploaded documents in case needed for verification, at The KARNATAKA SCHOOL EXAMINATION AND ASSESSMENT BOARD, 6th Cross, Malleswaram, Bengaluru – 560 003 at the time of Pre-Qualification scrutiny.

8. PRE-QUALIFICATION SCRUTINY

- i) The Pre-Qualification Bids will be scrutinized by KSEAB. The Pre-Qualification documents shall be evaluated by the Auction Scrutiny Committee constituted by the Director, KSEAB for confirming the eligibility criteria of the applicants. Thereafter, the pre-qualified bidders eligible for participation in e-Auctions would be informed through e-Auction Platform.
- ii) KSEAB reserves the right to reject all / any of the bids without assigning any reasons whatsoever.

9. CRITERIA TO CONSIDER BIDS INVITED THROUGH e-AUCTION: -

- i) "Old Question Papers" is "As is where is on weight basis' irrespective of approximate quantity mentioned in the e-auction document will be considered. The highest bidder for the weight(per Kg) is considered as the successful bidder and the bid will be awarded to such bidder subject to the condition mentioned under clause No:5, ii .
- ii) KSEAB reserves the right to reject all / any of the bids without assigning any reasons whatsoever.

10. LIFTING OF MATERIAL:

- i) The successful bidder / bidders shall lift and transport the material at their own cost within specified date as mentioned below.
 - a. PU Old question papers which are in various districts of Karnataka on AS is where it is basis on weight Basis pertaining to 2022-23 PU and Previous examinations should be lifted within 30 (thirty days) working days during office hours from the date of issue of work order.
- ii) **The AIA reserves the right to issue the order for lifting the material to the successful bidder.**

11. RESERVE PRICE: *

- i) The KSEAB has fixed a Reserve Price of 36 / Kg excluding all applicable taxes for the entire weight that includes PU Old question papers which are in various districts of Karnataka (Annexure enclosed) on AS is where it is basis on weight Basis pertaining to 2022-23 PU and Previous examinations. The bidder shall quote a price over and above the Reserve Price.
Note : " Reserve Price" is the minimum basic price of the material fixed by KSEAB as per prevailing market condition. Which excludes applicable taxes, Rates quoted Equal to or Less than the reserve price will not be accepted by the e-auction platform.

12. BID PRICE:-

- i) The incremental increase in a bid is fixed as 01 Rupee for "Printed Question Papers" and multiples thereof. Bids equal to or less than the reserve price will not be accepted by e-Auction platform of Government of Karnataka. The incremental bids quoted by the bidders are exclusive of all statutory taxes.

13. BID INCREMENT:

- i) The maximum incremental price is kept at 10 times the bid increment. The bid increment is the minimum increase amount over the last submitted price. So, any bidder can bid in multiple of Rs. **1 Rupee** per bidding for 'sale and disposal of PU Old question papers which are in various districts of Karnataka on AS is where it is basis on weight Basis pertaining to 2022-23 PU and Previous examinations' on 'As is where is basis' and multiples thereof.

14. DELTA TIME;

- i) Delta Time for sale of "PU Old question papers which are in various districts of Karnataka on AS is where it is basis on weight Basis pertaining to 2022-23 PU and Previous examinations" on 'AS IS WHERE IS BASIS' is set at 5 minutes. 5 minutes extension is given when any bidder submits

bid within the delta time before the scheduled time of closure of e-Auctions. If any bid submitted between 12.55 and 1.00 pm will extend the closure of e-Auctions by 5 minutes from the last submitted time and hence continues.

15. SALE AWARD:

- i) The successful bidder before lifting the material shall remit the full value of material and agreement should be done within seven days from the date of receiving the Letter of acceptance. Payment shall be made only **through Demand Draft from any Nationalized Bank only, drawn in favor of "The Director-Exams, KSEAB, Bengaluru or through RTGS to K.S.E.A Board Bank Account"**. Also, the successful bidder has to remit the Sales Tax/GST under prevailing rate to the competent GST authority under 'Reverse charge basis by the recipient' as per the Notification No: 4/2017-Central Tax (Rate) New Delhi, the 28th June, 2017 and amendment Notification No: 36 /2017-Central Tax (Rate) New Delhi, the 13th October, 2017 to the same, issued by Govt of India, Finance department.

16. FORCE MAJEURE CLAUSE: -

- i) In case, the contract could not be fulfilled / cancelled / terminated for any reason arising out of the laws / regulations / restrictions governing natural calamities, war / hostility, military operation of any character, civil commotions, sabotage, quarantine restriction, acts of Government embargoes, the successful bidder shall not be entitled for any compensation.

17. ARBITRATION: -

- i) Dispute that may arise between the parties, shall be settled through mutual discussion in good faith. The Director, KSEAB or his designated nominee shall be the sole Arbitrator for the purpose.

18. NON-ASSIGN ABILITY: -

- i) The Sale Award / Letter of Intent issued to the successful bidder is not transferable or assignable in whatsoever manner. The awardee shall remit the value of material and lift the allotted material himself by following the due procedure prescribed. KSEAB will not entertain any third-party nominee / assignee in what so ever manner on behalf of the awardee.

19. TERMINATION OF THE AGREEMENT: -

- i) In the event of any breach of any of the tender terms and conditions by the successful bidder and of the sale award or against the interest of The KSEAB shall be free to cancel the Sale Award / Delivery Order, but without prejudice to the claims of the KSEAB. The successful bidder shall have no claim against The KSEAB and the decision of the Director, KSEAB in this regard shall be final.
- ii) If the successful bidder does not lift the material within the specified period / extended period either if any in part or in full, Rs.20000/- penalty per day will be levied. Delay beyond 10 days, The KSEAB may take action for the forfeiture of Performance Security and lifting of materials will not be allowed thereafter.

20. PERIOD OF SALE: -



In the event of failure to lift the material, within the originally allowed or extended time as the case may be, penalty will be levied as per section 19(ii).
- ii) The responsibility of KSEAB ends once the material is made available to the successful bidder.

21. COMPENSATION TOWARDS NEGLIGENT ACTIONS / DAMAGES AT THE GODOWN:-

- i) Successful bidder / Sale awardee shall be responsible for any claims arising out of negligent actions / damages on the part of sale awardee on any property belonging to the Board and to their personnel, or in an accident involving any personnel or labour, during loading, transportation and unloading.


